Tournament Rules

1. The tournament is sanctioned by the B.T.B.A. and the general playing and tournament rules will govern this event together with the following rules.
2. The tournament is open to members of the B.T.B.A. Non-members and those unable to produce a current card will be charged a fine of £2. Non-members will not be eligible for B.T.B.A. services.
3. The tournament will be singles and will be scratch throughout. Ladies, Seniors (45+) & Juniors (under 18) will receive 8 pins bonus a game.
4. A provisional ball must be rolled if a dispute relating to pinfall cannot be resolved immediately. Protests must be made verbally at the time and confirmed in writing to the Tournament Director within 72 hours of the game in which the infraction occurred.
5. The Tournament Manager (Raymond Teece) reserves the right to reject or re-rate any entry and their decision on all matters shall be final, subject to appeal to the B.T.B.A.
6. All bowlers must register at least 15 minutes prior to the scheduled squad time and present their BTBA or National Association card. Tardy players will commence play at the frame in progress.
7. Ball checks will be conducted prior to the start of each squad and can be made at ANY time. It is the bowler's responsibility to ensure the ball meets all rules of the event. Any balls deemed to be in violation of the rules regarding equipment for this event will be disqualified from use.
8. In the event of a ball being disqualified prior to qualifying rounds, the bowler will have the choice of obtaining a replacement or having fees refunded and withdrawing from the event. During competition however, the bowler will be disqualified with no refund.
9. Bowlers must wear suitable bowling attire whilst competing in the event. Bowlers must wear a collared or bowling shirt and names do not need to be shown. Tailored shorts/hats will be allowed at the discretion of the Tournament Manager. Denim clothing, jeans and casual shorts of any description will not be permitted.
10. MP3 players must be turned off during match play and are not to be worn on the approach during play. Failure to comply after a warning will result in disqualification without refund.

11. Tie Rules: For qualifying, Final Step 1 and Round Robin; the higher place will be awarded to the bowler with the highest last game (exc. win/draw bonuses). Should there still be a tie, the penultimate game will be used, and so on until the tie is broken. For the stepladder finals; a 9th/10th frame roll-off will decide winner. The higher seeded player has choice of starting lane and order.
12. All prize fund monies shall be returned in full.
13. All bowlers will play 6 games qualifying, changing lanes after every game. The top 16 bowlers inc. all bonuses (and any ties) will qualify for Finals Step 1 and will play a further 4 games with their pinfall from qualifying carried forward. The top 6 after FS1 will play a 5-game round-robin with pinfall carried forward (30 pins for a win, 15 pins for a draw). The top 3 after the round-robin will play a stepladder final with each game starting from scratch. Higher seed has choice of starting lane.

Equipment Rules

- Balls must have a plastic or polyester coverstock
- Balls must show on USBC Approved Ball List
- Balls must NOT have a differential of higher than 0.020
- **NO WEIGHT HOLES PERMITTED**
- No plugging is permitted except for changes to span
- Serial Number of ball must match number declared on entry form
